Fr. Kevin's Reflection

Jesus knows us better than we know ourselves. We see this in this week's Gospel. His disciples Taking His words to heart in the Our Father each day gives us a spiritual reminder and uplift of all we are entrusted to do as the followers of Jesus and all we are truly capable of. By praying the Hail Mary we acknowledge Mary's powerful faith and her love for Jesus and us. In our imperfection but faith fired hope we say: "Pray for us sinners now and at the hour of our death." Like any mother she sees beyond our faults and imperfections to someone she loves with all her heart.

We also hear the voice of Jesus speaking to us through our consciences. At times we ponder what we should say or do. Openness to the Spirit of God enables us to hear the voice of Jesus and say or do what He would say or do. When someone tells us of a good thing that has happened to another person we know, we increase their joy with words of congratulations. When we thank people for what they have done for us, we increase their joy. At times we are told of those who are sick or mourning the loss of a loved one. Those words lead us to visit them and offer them words of comfort and love.

Each day is another opportunity to hear God's voice in all the ways we use to communicate with one another. The more we listen, the more we respond with our life-giving presence and words. The constant blessing is not only our life-giving words to others, but the chance to speak them from our hearts. Life-giving words are Resurrection words - they lift us both those who hear them and those speak them.

Spring & Summer Attire - Now that springtime is in the air this is a good time to remember summer will be coming upon us.

Of course, the dog days of summer begin the process of changing the winter clothes out with the lighter (more breathable) summer wear. But, before we put everything away...make sure you keep the more appropriate clothes in your closet for church. It is very important to remember: what you may be wearing on the beach or on the deck next to the swimming pool is not the appropriate attire for church. As you begin to sort what to store and what to keep, be sure to leave in your closet clothes that are comfortable...but at the same time...“dressy” in nature. Don't be stuck with tank tops, T-shirts, sandals, flip-flops and shorts as your only option. It is important to be comfortable...but not *too comfortable*...standing before God. Give more honor and respect than you'd give a prom date.

Adult Formation Classes at St. Augustine are on break until fall. If anyone you know would like to learn more about the faith, contact Fr. Kevin.

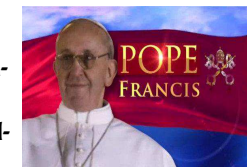
Bowdle and Hosmer are in need of more weekday Mass Intentions. The suggested donation is \$10 each. These would be used on Thurs, Fri and Sat.

Over the counter medications for infants, children, and adults (no gummies, as they melt)

* **Muscle rub cream (they use a lot of this! Please get the small tubes 1.5 oz found at Dollar Tree, not the larger 2-4oz size) this item is needed the most!**

* Anti-fungal cream (clotrimazole), Hydrocortisone cream, triple antibiotic ointment

* Eye lubricant drops, ear and eye antibiotic drops

* Sudafed or decongestant tablets

* TUMS Extra Strength, simethicone or gas medication

* Infant vitamin drops, chewable children's vitamins, prenatal vitamins, multivitamins

* Acetaminophen, Aspirin, Ibuprofen

Children's underwear, Dum Dum suckers, coloring books, colored pencils, markers (no crayons, they melt), notebooks and pencils, hair-clips, fingernail polish and remover, soap, toothpaste, toothbrushes, dental floss

Miniature toys (matchbox cars, stuffed animals) deflated soccer balls

Checks made out to "The Avera Foundation" will be used to the "Save a Family" program to purchase bred goats, prescription meds and for other needs.
