## Fr. Kevin's Reflection

It is essential that practicing Catholics, we renew our witness of Faith and Life. All of us are required to make this witness to the "Gospel of Life" in a public display. The greatest scandal to our country (and to our world) is the majority of the "American Catholic vote" is seduced by the pro-abortion, pro-contraception, pro-culture of death. We have chartered a 57-passenger bus to take area pro-lifers down to the Hour of Reflection and the Life Chain Walk on Sunday, January 21, 2018. The bus will pick up and drop off people in Aberdeen, Ipswich, Roscoe, Bowdle, Hoven, Gettysburg, and elsewhere along the way if needed. We will arrive in Pierre for the Life Chain Walk around the capitol by 12:30 pm. People are encouraged to bring their Right to Life banners or other pro-life signs. At 1:30 pm refreshments and snacks will be served in the capitol. At 2:00 pm the 45th Annual Hour of Reflection will be held in the capitol rotunda featuring keynote speaker South Dakota Attorney General Marty Jackley. The bus will head back around 3:30 pm.
