Fr. Kevin's Reflection

Growing up, I always remember the picture that hung over my grandfather's bed. Every Christmas, the Clan would gather ... and ... in order to get to the nearest bathroom (or at least the less used bathroom), you would have to go through grandma and grandpa's room to use theirs. And ... there I would see the Holy Family picture.

The Feast of the Holy Family is one of those days when I kind of feel sorry for a lot of people. You see growing up in an Irish family (where you know your fifth cousins) was not always the best ... you had to learn how to share! When you would bring the better of the gifts you got under the tree that year to the family gathering... you discovered nothing was ever *really just yours*. You had to learn how to wait your turn and the littlest always got to go first. (Thank goodness I was on that end of the family tree.)

Still we would look at the families who never "got together" with the clan ... and feel sorry for them. Who did they get to play with... who did they get so "show off" the prize gift of the year? Who was there to get them out of trouble with mom or dad? How did they deal with all that "alone" time just playing by themselves? Who did they find to play board games with? Who did they tease and chase around the house? What kind of stories did they tell if they were the only ones getting into trouble?

For myself being part of an Irish Clan, the Holy Family is more properly spelled, "wholly family". Our families are supposed to be modeled on the Holy Family; but, it is more the wholeness of the family that is what we are supposed to desire. This wholeness is the love ... compassion ... empathy ... spirit of caring ... spirit of teaching that Jesus shared with the world. We know that many of these elements of wholeness are not integral to the human person ... but rather ... are learned within the family context.

When you think about it ... where did Jesus learn / experience this wholeness? Jesus began in the home where He was raised, just as the wholeness of our "personhood" begins in the home. I remember often my grandfather saying, "these are not my rules, these are God's rules and you need to learn to follow them." Jesus was obedient to His father Joseph. Joseph must have been an incredible man! Why? Because ... when Jesus was asked how to pray ... it was Joseph who gave God His Name: "Our Father, Who art in heaven ..."

Our relationship with Jesus, Mary, Joseph and our Father in heaven is a family relationship and there are times we really need to reflect on that and how we are living that familial relationship out in our daily lives. Our Father in heaven: grandpa - nobody disappoints grandpa. Joseph: our father here on earth who teaches us a trade and a good work ethic. Mary our mother: who teaches us compassion, forgiveness, love and guidance: "*do whatever my Son tells you to do*". Jesus our brother: always has our back always gets us out of trouble and forgives all our failings. Our Holy Family is the best.
