### Church Support February 23 - 24

*Fr. Kevin's Reflection*

Well ... believe it or not ... Lent begins this week with Ash Wednesday, and each one of us is called by the Lord Jesus to a deeper conversion as we prepare to celebrate the Passover of the Lord at Easter. During these 40 Days of fasting, prayer, and works of mercy, let us strive to live in faithfulness to the promises of our Baptism ... promises which we will renew at Easter. "Are you unaware," Paul wrote to the Christians at Rome, "that we who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death? We were indeed buried with Him through baptism into death, so that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might live in newness of life." (Romans 6.3-4).

To live the new life of Baptism requires that we first die to sin and to ourselves and learn to live for Christ ... and the disciplines of Lent are meant to help us in the lifelong work of living by grace through faith in the Son of God. No matter your age, we are called to offer something each day of Lent as a sacrifice ... to remind us what sacrifice and passion we have for Jesus and Jesus has for each of us. Here are some of the practical ways we can do that in these 40 Days too:

+to begin - allow me to clear up a big misconception that is floating out there (even some Catholic publications are getting this wrong) ... "40 day" means Ash Wednesday to Holy Saturday ... this idea that Sundays are not included in Lent **does not come** from Catholic Tradition. (And, don't think I have been trying to figure away around this ... this year St. Patrick's Day is on a Sunday!) No way around it ... Sundays of Lent are Sundays of Lent. The "40 days" has always meant: a long period of time ... not literally 40 days.

+ come to the church and make a visit with our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament found here in the Tabernacle. How much we can come to better understand our Lord in the Garden of Gethsemane ... come and visit Him in the church Who is so often all alone.

+ give alms by making a donation ... for instance: to Birthright in Pierre or the Food Bank or by writing a check to the Dudley House in Sioux Falls (101 N Indiana Ave, Sioux Falls, SD 57103).

+ go to Confession on a Saturday afternoon. (Go early this Lent, and do not wait until Holy Week when the lines will be long.)


+ attend Daily Mass throughout Lent when it is offered in town.

+ push back from every meal **before you've had enough**. Walk away unsatisfied (being mindful of the body's hunger for food helps us understand the soul's hunger for the Lord, a hunger that is satisfied only when we give ourselves in the obedience of faith to the Gospel).

+ invite a lapsed Catholic to join you at Mass one Sunday in Lent. (A gentle invitation is often the only thing needed to bring a someone back to the Lord Jesus.)

+ invite a non-Catholic to walk the Way of the Cross with you each Friday of Lent at 7 pm and find the strength to heed the call of the Lord Jesus to take up your cross and follow Him. (The Way of the Cross is a unifying devotion of all Christians.)

*Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return.  
So repent, and believe in the Gospel*
