## Fr. Kevin's Reflection

Today as we begin Holy Week with our observance of Palm Sunday, we begin the celebrations of the most solemn, most ancient, and most sacred liturgies in the Church's tradition. Palm Sunday is the summary of the week to come. However, if you can make the celebrations themselves ... please do. They are filled with beautiful, age-old symbolism. This is the only week of the year designated as "Holy." And, nothing should detract us from entering fully into the celebration of these beautiful days which commemorate and make present the Paschal Mystery, the Central Mystery of our Faith — the Passion, Death, and Resurrection of Jesus Christ. As Scripture says, if Christ is not raised from the dead, then our faith is in vain [1 Corinthians 15:17].

The Holy Week Liturgies are truly moving and deeply grace-filled encounters with the 33 year old man ... Jesus. As in years past, we will begin our Holy Week liturgies on Wednesday evening at 7:00 pm with the Living Stations in Hoven (organized by the high schoolers). Then, on Thursday evening we begin The Easter Triduum: A liturgy spread over three days, the Easter Triduum is at the center of the Church's liturgical year - hence the name Triduum, from the Latin for "three" days. It consists of Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday.

Like I just wrote, consider your celebration of this most Holy Week. Join us as we prepare to celebrate the central liturgy of our Faith. Also, don't forget to make a good confession of your sins in preparation for the coming feast of Easter — ample times are being provided. Check the bulletin for confession times. I hope to see all of you this week. Your sacrifice of time and effort would please Jesus, so much. May you grow in holiness, and in your hope of the Resurrection!

Remember to keep Holy Week, HOLY. Give Jesus your heart, and He will give you Heaven!
