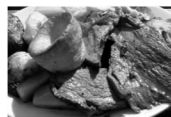

## Fr. Kevin's Reflection

*Exult, let them exult, the hosts of heaven, exult,  
 let Angel ministers of God exult,  
 let the trumpet of salvation sound aloud*

*our mighty King's triumph!*

Chanted at the beginning of the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday night, these words announce the Lord's Resurrection to all, as we begin the celebration of the Lord's rising to new life. Easter is the most magnificent Sunday of the Church year. In fact, it is the greatest of Sundays. The crowds are larger than normal. The churches are magnificently decorated. Choirs and musicians do their best. Easter celebrates the core mystery of our Christian faith — the Resurrection of Jesus from the dead. If Christ has not been raised, your faith is in vain... But, thanks be to God who gives us victory through out Lord Jesus Christ. [see 1Cor 15-17]

The Resurrection of Jesus offers hope to believers. If we persevere in faith, we will one day enjoy eternal life in heaven. Through Baptism, all of us have been given a share in the joy and promise of Christ's Resurrection. Scripture tells us.. If we have died with him, in the waters of Baptism, we will also rise with Him. If we are faithful to Him, we will reign with Him! [2 Timothy 2:11-12]

The Resurrection also offers new life and healing to us in the here and now of our lives on earth. This is so because the power of the Risen Lord Jesus is not confined to some distant place in heaven, but is with us now, through the presence of the Holy Spirit.

Finally, the Resurrection reminds us that ultimately, God has the last word. Just as God the Father raised Jesus from the dead, so does He bring good out of any hardship we face. This is a promise of the Easter, provided we have the courage to persevere in faith. Easter tells us that sin and death do not have the last word: God has the last word, and his Word is ALWAYS good! It brings eternal life, peace, forgiveness, and happiness to those who seek Him.

**I hope all of you have a wonderful Easter! May your faith in Jesus be renewed, and may you grow in holiness. I invite you to join us each Sunday as we celebrate our faith in Jesus, risen and living among us. In the Holy Eucharist He gives us Himself... come each Sunday to receive this great gift of love.**
