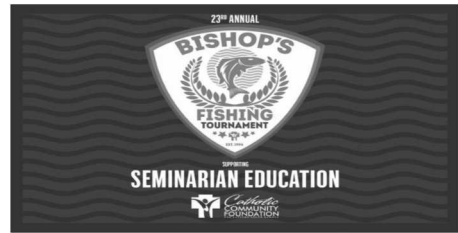

Fr. Kevin's Reflection

Now that springtime is in the air this is a good time to remember summer will be coming upon us. Of course, the dog days of summer begin the process of changing the winter clothes out with the lighter (more breathable) summer wear. But, before we put everything away...make sure you keep the more appropriate clothes in your closet for church. It is very important to remember what you may be wearing on the beach or on the deck next to the swimming pool is not the appropriate attire for church. As you begin to sort what to store and what to keep, be sure to leave in your closet clothes that are comfortable... but at the same time.... "dressy" in nature. Don't be stuck with tank tops, t-shirts, sandals, flip-flops and shorts as your only option. It is important to be comfortable... but not too comfortable...standing before God, give honor and respect.

Today we celebrate the Fourth Sunday of Easter. We continue to celebrate the Lord's rising to new life. We continue to ask ourselves how we are doing as disciples of Christ in the 21st century. In His resurrection, Jesus gives us Himself, He continues His presence in the lives of His people, and wants our happiness, and our salvation. In today's Gospel the Lord Jesus invites us to follow Him, *to be the sheep of His flock*. We are to follow Christ as the sheep follow the shepherd... for as the shepherd cares for his sheep, so Christ cares for each of us in so many ways. Especially through the Sacraments.
