Fr. Kevin's Reflection

We are all familiar with the "Christmas Season." Television and newspapers are full of stories about the "holiday season." Christmas "Joy" begins around Thanksgiving and lasts, culturally, at least through January 1st (even though the liturgical season of Christmas doesn't end until mid-January with the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord).

Easter is the same way. It's not just a day, it's an entire season. The joy and exultation the Church feels at the Resurrection of Jesus cannot be contained to just one period of twenty-four hours — Easter Sunday. Rather than being an "end" to Holy Week, or merely the culmination of our Lenten preparation, Easter Sunday is the beginning of an entire liturgical season that lasts seven weeks.

Today, we celebrate the Fifth Sunday of Easter. Our Easter joy continues for three more weeks, when we will celebrate the Solemnity of Pentecost... the outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon the Blessed Virgin Mary and the Apostles, and the beginning of the Church's mission to preach Christ to the ends of the earth.

Let's keep our Easter joy alive in our hearts and in our homes. Easter blessings to you, and all those you love!

WARNING: Mobile and Email Phishing Scam

There have been many reports of both email and texting scams happening within parishes of the diocese this past week. Parishioners have been receiving text messages and emails claiming to be from their pastor asking for assistance. The emails and texts were sent from unknown accounts. However, the use of the pastor's name caused individuals to believe it was, in fact, "Father" who was reaching out to them. Unfortunately some parishioners have lost money to this scam as they were tricked into purchasing gift cards for a fake cause. **At the encouragement of the SD Attorney General's Office, we urge all parishioners to be mindful: Father _____ (and the parish office) will never ask for money or gift cards via text message or email.**

If you receive a text or email asking for money or gift cards, you should always call the parish office to verify. You can also report it to the SD Attorney General's office at 1-800-300-1986. Their office is investigating this scam.
