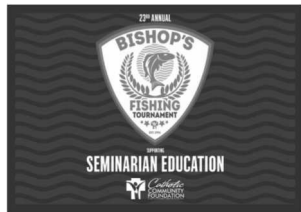

## Fr. Kevin's Reflection

This week we celebrate Memorial Day ... in thankful appreciation for those who offered themselves for the sake of our country. We MOST especially give thanks to those who offered the ultimate price for us. (And, let us not forget our Gold Star mothers ... whose sacrifice we can only appreciate.)

The month of May is traditionally dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary. As we come to the end of our May celebrations ... let's not leave it without reflecting about her. (If anyone who can be a Gold Star Mother ... she stood next to the Savior of the World ... for the salvation of all (past, present and future)). After the Ascension of the Lord Jesus into Heaven ... as they awaited the outpouring of the Holy Spirit ... the Apostles must have been comforted by the presence of the Mother of Jesus. Certainly her maternal care must have been a great blessing to the followers of the Lord. Likewise, because of the love she has for her children, the Church has always held her in high esteem, accorded her great honor, and "pride of place" in the "heart of the Church." She is the Mother of Jesus — the Mother of God, the Mother of the Church, and "mother" to each and every one of us.

While we continue on in our celebration of Easter, we end this month dedicated to the honor of the Blessed Virgin Mary. What a beautiful place our parish would be if every parishioner were renewed in our faith, love, and desire for Jesus in this wonderful gift of Himself. Mary offers us the "model" to follow. Her love and faith is perfect. Her discipleship, her following of the Lord, is complete. ### Warning: Mobile and Email Phishing Scam

There have been many reports of both email and texting scams happening within parishes of the diocese this past week. Parishioners have been receiving text messages and emails claiming to be from their pastor asking for assistance. The emails and texts were sent from unknown accounts. However, the use of the pastor's name caused individuals to believe it was, in fact, "Father" who was reaching out to them. Unfortunately some parishioners have lost money to this scam as they were tricked into purchasing gift cards for a fake cause. **At the encouragement of the SD Attorney General's Office, we urge all parishioners to be mindful: Father \_\_\_\_\_ (and the parish office) will never ask for money or gift cards via text message or email.**

If you receive a text or email asking for money or gift cards, you should always call the parish office to verify. You can also report it to the SD Attorney General's office at 1-800-300-1986. Their office is investigating this scam.
