Fr. Kevin's Reflection

Today is Father's Day ... how great it is that our secular society remembers the importance of mothers and fathers in our midst ... The vitality they give to our nation. Jesus, Himself, gives us a reason to celebrate today ... when it came to revealing Who God is ... He gave us His Father for us to relate.

There is so much more to God than we can ever comprehend. This is the mystery we celebrate today, Trinity Sunday. The Trinity — three persons in one God — offers us a model for living. Just as Three Persons of the Trinity are united as one, we must strive to live in ever greater unity with God and with one another.

So much can be said about the nature of God, and as much as we can say there is infinitely more that we cannot say or know. This is the mystery of God we celebrate today: God Who gave Himself to us as a Father who created us, the Son Who redeemed us, and the Holy Spirit Who sanctifies and guides us. Yet, there are not three gods, but only ONE: Three distinct Persons in One eternal God. A mystery we can contemplate and comprehend in one sense, but nonetheless a mystery that escapes our understanding ... and so we stand in awe and wonder of this beautiful mystery, and seek to draw closer to Him throughout our lives so that we can be happy with Him forever in Heaven. For now we see in a mirror dimly, but then face to face. Now I know in part; then I shall know fully, even as I have been fully known. [cf. 1 Corinthians 13:12]

For me ... when I meditate on the Mystery of the Trinity ... an insight will come (be revealed). And, I approach deeper into prayer ... and the insight will just escape my fingertips as I reach out to know more. No to be teased by God ... but to hunger for Him and be filled by Him that much more.

Know of my prayers for the fathers out there. You are called by God the Father to model Him in our lives. May one father to Another ... bless you on this day especially!
