Fr. Kevin's Reflection

The "Summer feasts" of Pentecost, Trinity Sunday, and Corpus Christi are over. Liturgically, we have settled into the weeks of Ordinary Time: Counting the days and weeks of the year, entering into the rhythm of the "daily living" of discipleship. And, we will, for the next several weeks, be hearing in our readings the moral teaching of Christ... how we are to live as His followers.

Now that we have returned to Ordinary Time, I want to pick up where I left off back in February. Why we do what we do at the celebration of the Mass. You may recall, I wrote about using the High Altar for the Solemnities. I know some will ask what the big deal is. Is Fr. Kevin going nostalgic for some reason? And, hopefully the Gospel makes some sense to this question. We are called to follow Him ... all is to be focused on Him ... we unite in Worship Him ... all direct our attentions to Him. It is not about us and "what we feel". Our worship (as Orthodox and Catholics) is what Jesus feels for the will of the Father and offers Himself for our sake on the Altar of the Cross and our Altar 2000 years later. (Do this in remembrance of Me. [cf. Mark 14:22, Luke 22:18-20, 1 Cor 11:23-25]).

So ... after Vatican II ... why did everything change from the High Altar to a table Altar in the center of the sanctuary? Why did the focus seem to change? (The key word to this question is: seem. The focus and liturgy never changes ... it is eternal and perfect.) So ... what happened? When people visit the Vatican in Rome ... you find the Altar to be in the center of the church. The ordering of St. Peter's was then copied, so it would seem, in many other pilgrim churches in Rome. (For the purposes of this discussion, we do not need to go into the disputed details of this process. The controversy after Vatican II was triggered by another innovation. Because of topographical circumstances, it turned out that St. Peter's faced west. Thus, if the celebrating priest wanted - as the Christian tradition of prayer demands - to face east, he had to stand behind the people and look - this is the logical conclusion - toward the people.) For whatever reason it was done, one can also see this arrangement in a whole series of church buildings within St. Peter's direct sphere of influence. The liturgical renewal in after Vatican II took up this alleged model and developed from it a new idea for the form of the liturgy. The Eucharist - so it was said - had to be celebrated *toward the people* (versus populum). The altar (as can be seen in the model of St. Peter's) had to be positioned in such a way that priest and people looked at each other and formed together the circle of the celebrating community. This alone, so it was said, was compatible with the meaning of the Christian liturgy, with the requirement of *active participation*. This alone conformed to the early model of the Last Supper.

These arguments seemed in the end so persuasive that after the Council (which says nothing about "turning toward the people") new altars were set up everywhere, and today celebration *toward the people* (versus populum) really does look like the characteristic fruit of Vatican II's liturgical renewal. In fact it is the most conspicuous consequence of a reordering that not only signifies a new external arrangement of the places dedicated to the liturgy, but also brings with it a new idea of the essence of the liturgy... the liturgy as a communal meal. (This, of course, is a misunderstanding of its significance ... but more about this next week.)
