Just a bit from Fr. Schmidt

While I was serving as a priest at the Cathedral in Sioux Falls, we regularly said Mass for the Perpetual Adoration Sisters of the Blessed Sacrament, whose monastery is now across the parking lot from the Cathedral of St. Joseph. They wanted to share a unique opportunity with us, so at the Masses this weekend, we have a first-class relic (from the body) of the Mother Foundress of their order, Blessed Maria Magdalena of the Incarnation.

Some people are kind of weirded out by the veneration of relics in Catholic practice, but it's a beautiful reminder of the Incarnation and that in a real way when God became Man, He sanctified not only our spirits or souls, but also our bodily existence and material realities. Of course the sacraments that communicate grace to us have material components, and whether it was the hem or tassel of Jesus' garment (Mt. 9:20), Peter's shadow (Acts 5:15-16) or handkerchiefs that Paul had touched (Acts 19:11-12), or even in the Old Testament, the bones of the Prophet Elisha (2 Kings 13:21), we know that God often chooses to work miracles through relics that once had a close connection to His holy ones.
