### St Augustine Council Meeting, Sunday, January 26

Fr. Schmidt asked for input from all present, as to what areas should be prioritized first for St Augustine repairs or attention. It was the consensus of the council and people present to tackle the following areas. **Floor in basement** of men's restroom, bottom of stairs on north side, and kitchen. Cement removal and replaced and tiled. The **main church doors** on the west side of the church, quote was accepted from House of Glass for replacement. Pauer Sound quote was accepted for specific items to update and make a complete **sound system**. A quote was accepted for **Main front steps** to be repaired and a non-slip coating applied for protection and safety by a company when outdoor temps favorable for project. It will likely be necessary to have the collapsing **brick at the sides** of the front steps repaired before the steps themselves are addressed, so someone to do brick work is being sought. **Rose stained glass window** has been need of immediate repair in choir loft area for many years now and others facing west are needing repair soon. A quote was accepted for this. A quote for replacing the badly-cracked **outer window** of the rose window included a surcharge for a lift, if we could not provide one. **Wall of the west stairwell** needs repainting. **Holy Trinity and St Augustine items** will be sorted by Fr Schmidt and anything not being of use in the foreseeable future will be cleared out, freeing up space. A thank you was addressed to **Arnold Peck** for the installing the shelves in the storage room. **10 old/heavy tables** were deemed surplus. **First Communion** is Sun April 26 @ Bowdle. Pending Bishop elect DeGroot's approval, **Confirmation** for both parishes is Sat April 25 @ Hoven. **Council members terms and meetings** are to meet diocesan policy guidelines, meetings at least 4 times annually, and members follow terms, may consider prorating terms to restructure, so not all terms end the same year. Last known council members will be contacted to find out if they still want to be on, more council members are needed to fill all positions.

## Just a bit from Fr. Schmidt

### Forty Hours Devotion

Forty days after the Nativity of Christ, Joseph and Mary brought Jesus to the Temple to consecrate Him to God as a firstborn Son and to offer a pair of turtledoves for Mary's purification after childbirth, according to Levitical law. The number 40 shows up quite a few times in Sacred Scripture, from the number of days it rained during the flood of Noah, to the number of years that Moses led the Israelites through the desert and the years of King David's reign. In the New Testament, we have the 40 days that Jesus spent in the desert after His Baptism in the Jordan and the days that He spent with His Apostles between His Resurrection and the Ascension.

Another instance that I recently came across was the tradition that Jesus spent about 40 hours in the tomb, from 3 pm on Good Friday to around 7 am on Easter Sunday. Of course, the precise hour that the Resurrection occurred on that first Easter morning is not recorded in the Bible, but from this and other occurrences of the number 40 developed what's called the 40 Hours Devotion. The **40 Hours Devotion** usually involves Solemn Exposition of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament for a continuous period of 40 hours. Along with the Corpus Christi Procession, the 40 Hours Devotion is expected to happen at least once a year in each parish.

Part of the challenge, of course, is that we are never to leave Jesus exposed upon the altar even for a moment without someone there to adore Him and to keep guard in the church. The nighttime hours can be particularly challenging to fill. Lent seems like an especially appropriate season for us to observe this time-honored practice as we all are called to recommit ourselves to spiritual exercises of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. And if we desire spiritual renewal in our parishes, spending time with Jesus in the Most Blessed Sacrament is the surest way.

To limit the 40 hours to just one overnight period, I'm thinking of going from **6 am on a Saturday** morning to **10 pm on Sunday**. We'll plan on the first weekend of Lent following Ash Wednesday in **Bowdle: February 29** and **March 1**, and the following weekend in **Hoven: March 7 & 8**. I'll have a signup sheet available at the entrance of each church. Please be generous to God with your time and commit to one or more hours as part of your Lenten discipline. Your time spent with our Eucharistic Lord will never go unrewarded.
