Renewing the Parish Councils

When I was younger, winter was always my favorite season of the year. I'm not quite sure I feel that way about it anymore, but the snow still *looks* pretty as it falls and blankets the ground and the tree branches. It doesn't always have a good effect on the roads, however, so please take extra care. I am looking forward to using the fireplace in Hoven again as the days grow shorter.

We recently received final reports from an audit of parish finances carried out by someone from the diocesan offices. We'll take a look at these at our next **parish council meetings**. As I understand it, meetings were infrequent in more recent years before my arrival, and we've continued to struggle to have clear membership and regular meetings. I've proposed having one council in each parish, serving the functions of both a finance and pastoral council, meeting quarterly to review the financial position of the parish and to advise and assist me on various matters pertaining to the life of the parish. Other parishioners should also feel comfortable bringing concerns to me directly and to the members of the council. As always, meeting dates and times are announced in the bulletin, allowing anyone to attend.

Since I've discontinued having regular Masses at St. John the Baptist in Onaka, there are also some who attended there who are no longer interested in serving on the St. Anthony Parish Council much longer. In both parishes we need new membership, and we need to have four meetings each year. If you would be willing to serve on the parish council—or if you know of someone who really should be willing—**please let me know** so that we can have a clear roster before we meet in November.

I'm very grateful for the support of so many, and I'm aware of how busy your schedules can be with so many activities to balance. To all who have served on parish councils in previous years and to those who continue or who are just starting out, you have my thanks and the gratitude of your fellow parishioners for the sacrifices you make to carry on the legacy of faith handed down from those who built these churches on the prairie and to ensure that many more will continue to encounter the living God in our parishes for many years to come.
