## Just a bit from Fr. Schmidt

### Last Half of Ordinary Time

The ceiling crew in Hoven has been putting in long hours and making good progress on the new plaster and paint. The latest I've heard is that they are hopeful to be finished even within a few weeks. Your patience and flexibility are greatly appreciated as we carry out these important repairs. Many were aware of the arch on the north wall in front of the choir loft, whose plaster had mostly fallen down already, but there was another spot over the Pieta in front of Mary's altar where pieces had been falling more recently, and a slight touch from one of the workers brought bigger pieces down. It's good that we were able to address these problems before anyone was injured by falling debris.

With September comes pretty much the midpoint of what remains of this liturgical year. If Ordinary Time or Time after Pentecost resumed sometime in June, that gives us close to six months between the Easter season and Advent in December. From June till August, we'd been learning and using the Mass parts labeled as the "Missa Simplex" in our *Credo* hymnals. With about three months remaining before Advent, we've returned to singing the *Roman Missal* chants, or what both the Missalette and hymnal use as sort of a default setting in line with the text of the other ordinary parts of the Mass.

These are named for the *Roman Missal*, which is the big book I use on the altar, because they are the same chant settings used there. Because of this, I've always considered them the most useful, for example, when we have visiting priests or a priest filling in. While not every priest in our diocese or in the world would be familiar with the *Credo* hymnal or the various Mass settings available in other publications, every priest who celebrates the Mass in English has familiarity with the *Roman Missal*, even if they are not all gifted singers.

One Mass part I've started doing in Latin more often on Sundays, since the response is always "Amen," is called the *Doxology*, which is a fancy word from Greek for "word of glory/praise." The one I'm referring to here concludes the Eucharistic Prayer right before the Our Father: Per ipsum et cum ipso et in ipso: "through Him (Christ) and with Him and in Him"—est tibi Deo Patri omnipotentis: "is to You, God the Father almighty"—in unitate Spiritus Sancti: "in the unity of the Holy Spirit"—omnis honor et gloria: "all honor and glory"—per omnia saecula saeculorum: "through all ages of ages."
